3. ACCOMMODATION

After handing in the housing request form together with the application, students will be given a room in a dormitory. Requests can be made, however the placing will the done by the Studentenwerk (Student Services) and changes can not be made. Students should only contact the international office of Hochschule Ulm with questions regarding the housing. We will inform students about their accommodation 3-4 weeks before arrival. By then they will have to sign a contract.

4. COSTS

All students have to pay an activity fee of €61,-. Housing costs are €270,-- to €360,-- per month. For living expenses including health insurance, transportation and food, students should calculate a minimum of €650,-- per month.

5. GERMAN LANGUAGE COURSES

As an additional part of the course Hochschule Ulm offers German language classes on different levels and a Englisch taught class in "German History". Also many field trips to different companies in the area are organized. To get to know Germany and German culture the International Office organizes excursions, for example to the Oktoberfest in Munich, to the Christmas Market in Nürnberg or to the Neuschwanstein Castle.

The intensive German language pre-semester course is optional. However, all students will have to attend the German language course which runs throughout the semester once a week.
