The intercultural approach in the Hatun Ñan affirmative action's programs

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The International Network Group of Intercultural Studies of the *Pontificia Universidad Católica del Perú* (RIDEI-PUCP) is an interdisciplinary team which conducts researches about the exercise of citizenship in contexts of cultural diversity, and promotes actions of intercultural education in different fields of social life.

RIDEI-PUCP was created in 2002 as coordinator and executor team of a regional project of intercultural education citizenship for indigenous peoples of Latin America, under which inter-learning workshops were developed in Bolivia, Peru, Nicaragua, Mexico, Ecuador and Brazil. Subsequently, a support project to the incorporation of intercultural citizenship in affirmative action programs that are developed in the *Universidad San Antonio Abad del Cusco* and the *Universidad San Cristóbal of Huamanga* in Ayacucho was adopted, to interculturalize our universities. Then, a research developed by professors of the three universities will be published, as part of our editorial line about the study and reflection on the university intercultural questions.

RIDEI-PUCP organizes its work in networks and institutional alliances facilitating the development of projects and activities aimed at promoting changes to improve our society fairer in which the coexistence is fed by the mutual learning without prejudices between groups and individuals of different social and cultural origins.
